

Atlanta I-85 Bridge Closure Information



Earlier in April a section of Interstate 85 just north of downtown Atlanta caught fire and collapsed, causing officials to close this stretch of roadway while repairs are made. The current construction timeline indicates I-85 between I-75 and SR 400 will remain closed through mid-June.

This road closure will only affect those travelling from North of Atlanta.

Above is a map outlining the current detours. Important items to note are:

- I-85 is closed in both directions from I-75 to SR 400.
- I-85 northbound traffic (guests commuting to Buckhead from Georgia World Congress Center) will be diverted to Buford-Spring Connector, an access road adjacent to I-85.
- Motorists are advised to use I-75, I-285 and I-20 until further notice.
- Georgia Department of Transportation signage around the city is a great resource to guide visitors once they arrive.
- Guests coming in from Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport will not be affected as the airport is south of the city.

If you do plan to drive to the NRA Annual Meetings & Exhibits, we recommend using Google Maps or download the Waze app (free to download on your mobile device) for the most up-to-date traffic information.

There are options for alternative routes so if you plan ahead, any inconvenience or extra time needed should be minimal.
